When I'm cold, I want some heat.



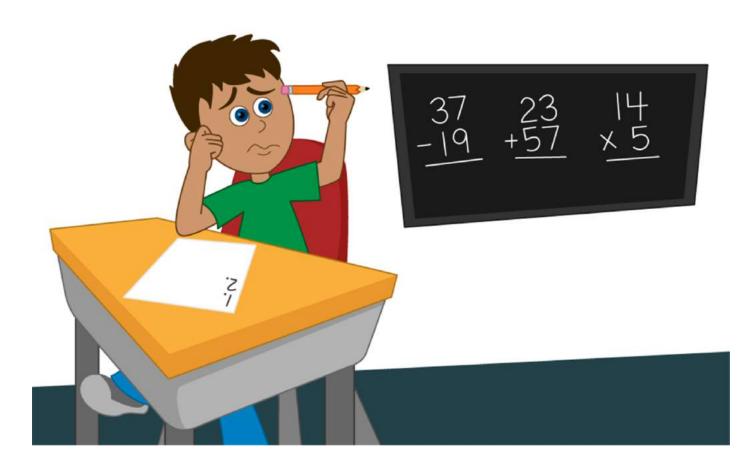
When I'm excited, I want to leap.



When I'm tired, I want to sleep.



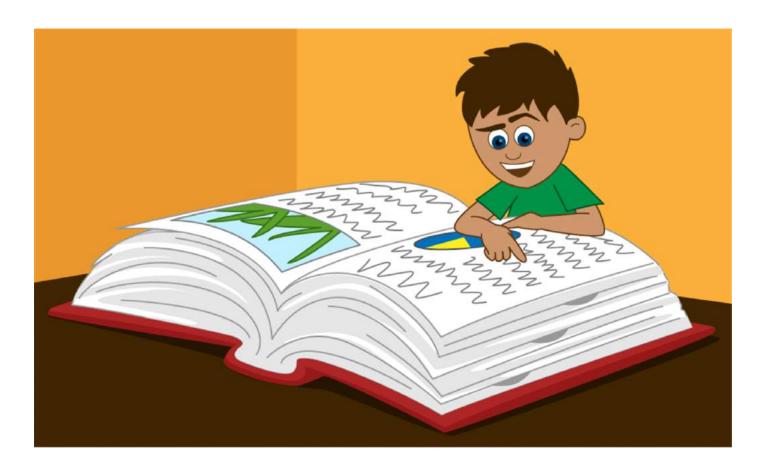
When I'm thirsty, I want a drink.
