

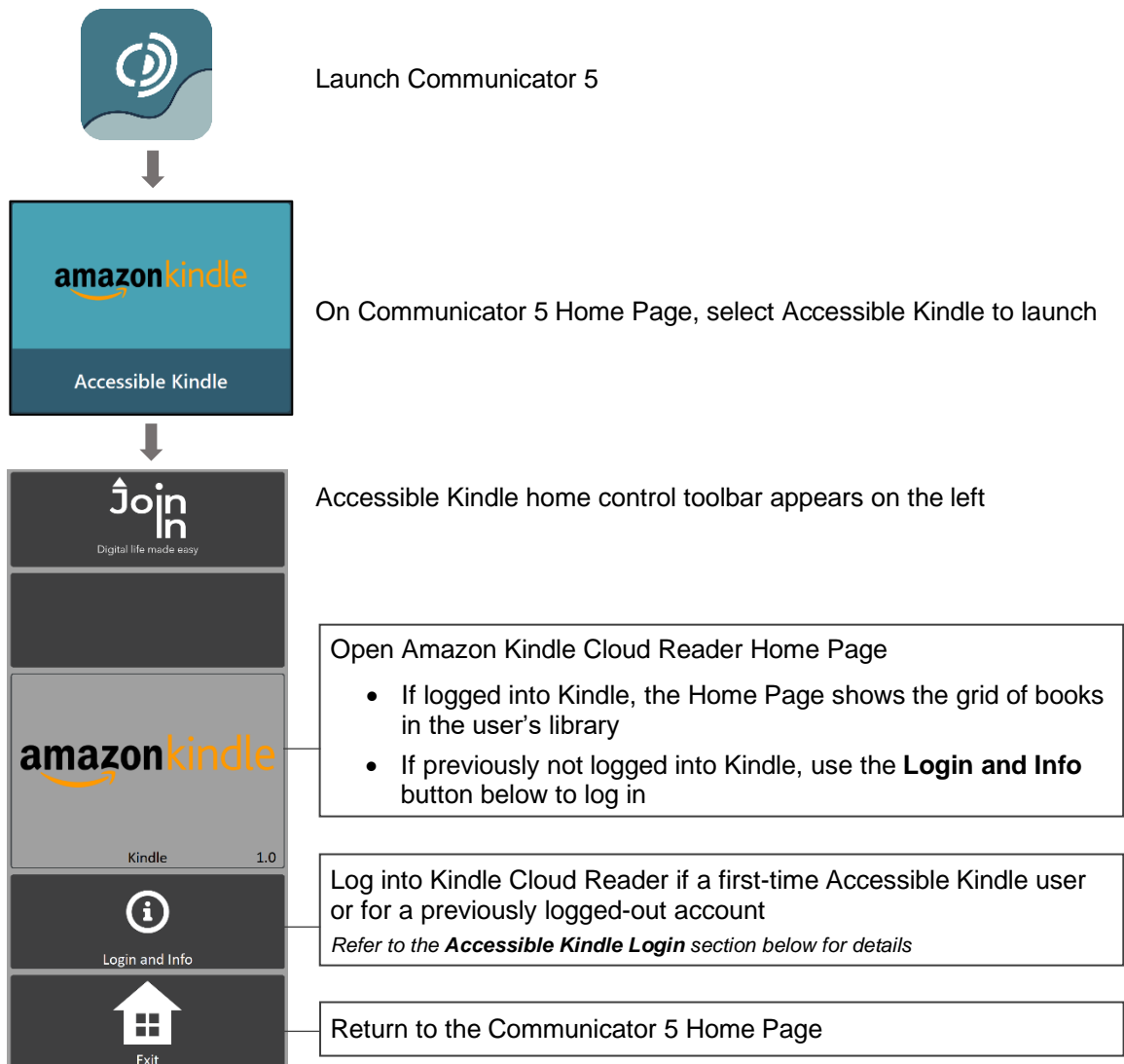
# Communicator 5 Accessible Apps - Accessible Kindle: Quick Guide

This document provides instructions on how to use Accessible Kindle to read books.

**Requirements:** To use Accessible Kindle, an (Amazon) Kindle account is required. If a user has not logged in with Accessible Kindle previously, make sure to have the login credentials available. An unlocked device with access to the Internet is also required.

After selecting **Login and Info** on the home control toolbar, the left toolbar provides buttons for signing in, signing out and more.

Open the main control toolbar (on the left) and Kindle Cloud Reader Home Page (on the right)

Sign out from Kindle Cloud Reader

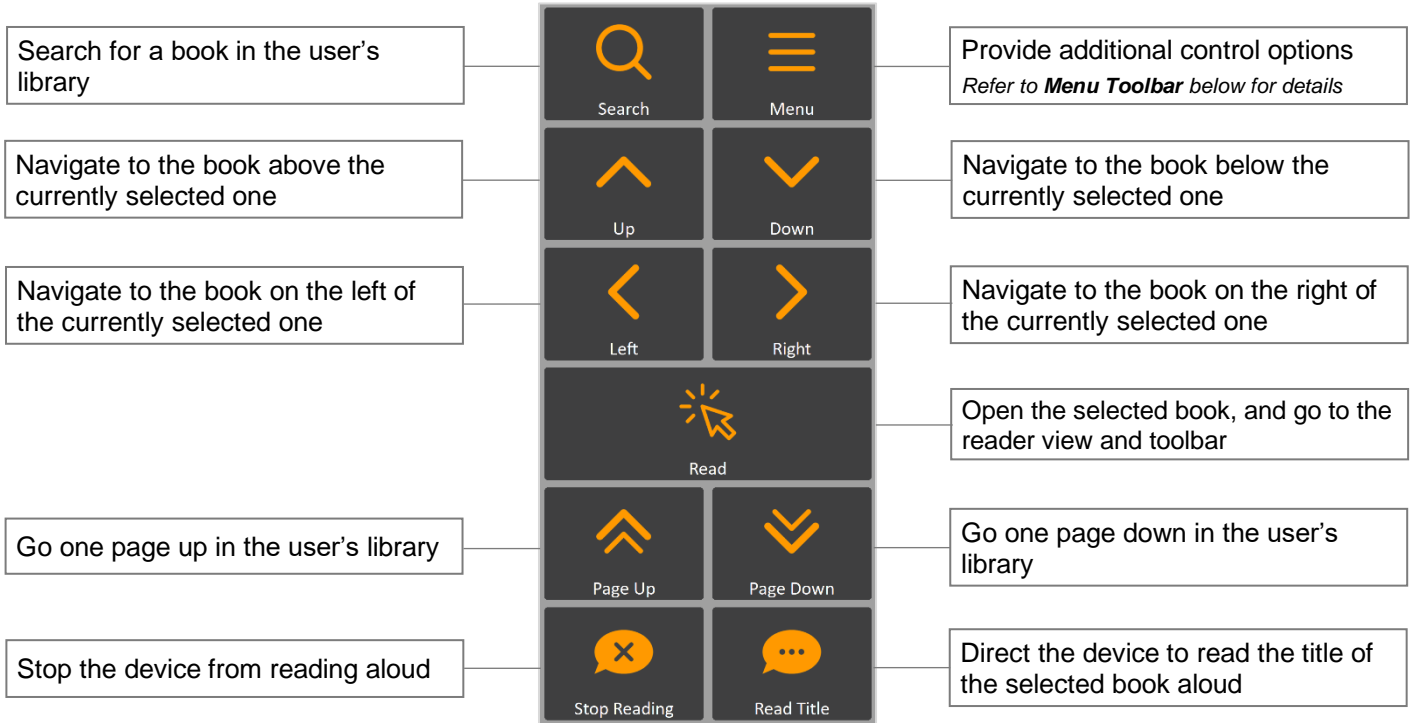
Return to the Communicator 5 Home Page

- **Sign In**

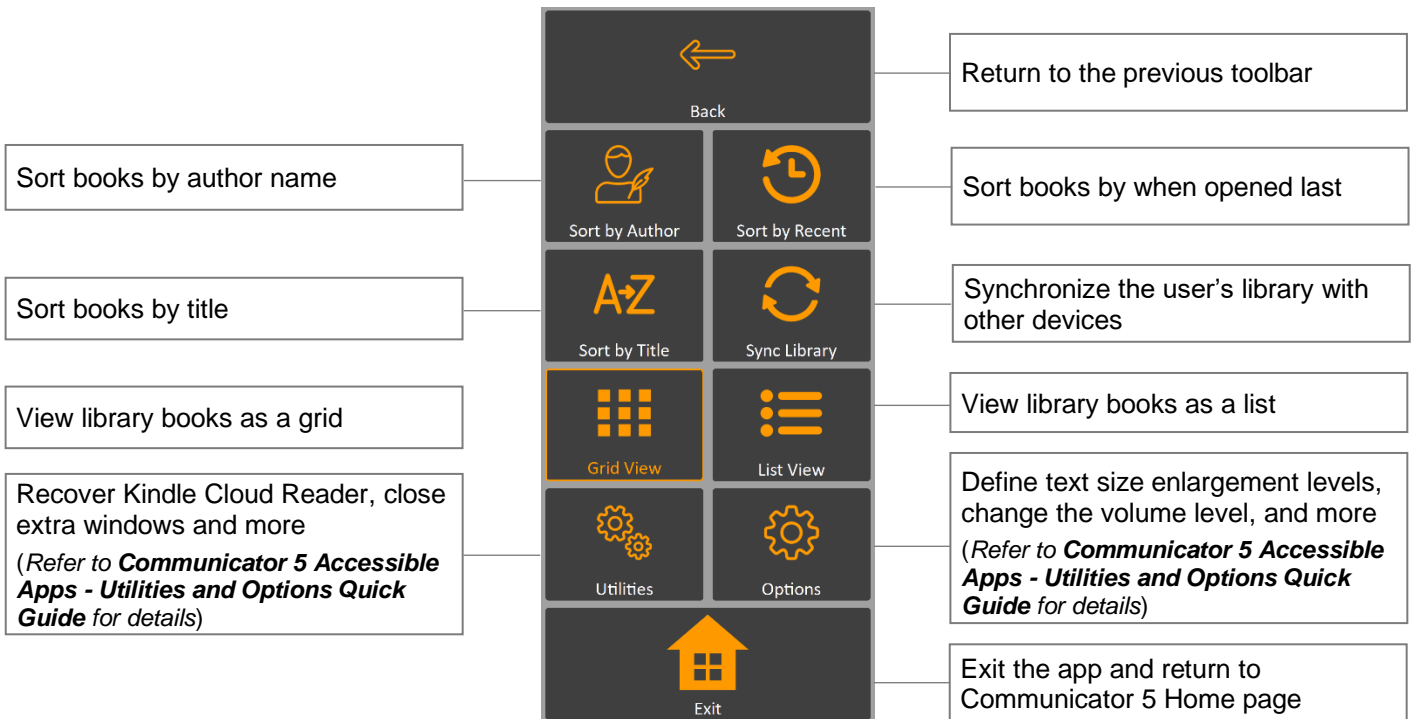
## Browse Library
